PKGB employees to launch protests from July 9

BALLARI, DHNS: The Pragathi Krishna Gramin Bank employees will start various stages of protest from July 9 to press for their various demands including the regularisation of jobs.

Informing this to reporters in Ballari on Monday, Pragathi Krishna Gramin Bank Employees Association President H Tippeswamy took exception to the Bank obtaining a stay from the Court on the inquiry being held by the EPF Organisation into the allegations of non-payment of provident fund to the employees.

"The bank has ignored the High Court order directing it to pay pension to the retired employees," he charged, and added that launching a protest against these injustice had become inevitable.

The Association is planning to paste its charter of demands at the entrance of all the branches of the Bank, from July 9 to July 16.

Pamphlets will be distributed in the City on July 12, and a protest will be held in front of the Bank's head office in Ballari on July 16, he informed.
