- 1. The above results of The Sandur Manganese and Iron Ores Limited ("the company") for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 were reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board and approved by the Board of Directors at the respective meetings held on February 6, 2019 and February 7, 2019. The Statutory Auditors of the Company have carried out a limited review of the same.
- 2. The figures for the three months ended on December 31, 2018 are the balancing figures between unaudited figures in respect of the nine months ended December 30, 2018 and the published figures of the half year ended September 30, 2018.
- 3. These financial results have been prepared in accordance with Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and in terms of the Listing Regulations, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.
- Post the applicability of Goods and Service tax (GST) with effect from 1st July 2017, sales are required to be disclosed net of GST. Revenue from operations for the quarter and nine months ended December 31, 2018 are not comparable with the previous period presented in the results.
- 5. Effective April 01, 2018, the Company has adopted Ind AS 115 Revenue from Contracts with customers under the modified retrospective approach without adjustment of comparatives. The Standard is applied to contracts that remain in force as at April 01, 2018. The application of the standard did not have any significant impact on the retained earnings as at April 01, 2018 and financial results for the current and previous quarter.
- 6 During the quarter ended 31st December 2017, the Company has reviewed that the point of transfer of risks and rewards for revenue recognition on sale of Manganese and Iron ore under e-auction has changed such that point of sale is shifted from that of actual despatch of minerals to the completion of e-auction sales and receipt of money from the buyer.
- 7. The Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on 14 February, 2018 have approved the Scheme of Amalgamation ("the draft Scheme") of Star Metallics & Power Pvt Ltd, (Subsidiary company), with the Company effective from the appointed day of 1 April, 2018. Requisite adjustment will be carried out subsequent to compliances/ approval of appropriate authorities in the books of the Company.

3. The figures of the previous periods have been regrouped / reclassified where necessary.
